

Registering for and Taking the Colorado Journeyman Wireman Exam

All of E Light's Apprentices are expected to register for and take the Colorado Journeyman Wireman Exam once they reach 8,000 hours of On-the-Job Training, as required by state law. This is a condition of an Apprentice's continued employment.

Any Journeyman who is employed by E Light but holds a license from a state that is not reciprocal with Colorado's licensing requirements will have to take the Colorado Journeyman Wireman Exam. A Journeyman who holds a license in a state that is reciprocal with Colorado's licensing requirements can skip to Part 2 of this guide.

The process is very similar for both Apprentices and transferring Journeymen. The following is a step by step guide to registering for and taking the exam.

Part I: Soon-to-Be Journeymen and Journeymen from States not Reciprocal with Colorado's Licensing Requirements

A Little about Licensure Reciprocity: Some states offer Licensure Reciprocity for electrical tradespersons who move to other states under the National Electrical Reciprocal Alliance (NERA). However, not all states have reciprocity with one another. For example, a Colorado Journeyman electrician's license is reciprocated in the following 12 states: Alaska, Arkansas, Idaho, Iowa, Massachusetts, Minnesota, Montana, Nebraska, New Hampshire, New Mexico, North Dakota, Oklahoma, South Dakota, Utah, and Wyoming. So, if a Colorado Journeyman Electrician moved to South Carolina, they would need to retest to keep their Journeyman license active in the state. NCCER created an [interactive map](#) that will tell you which state's your state has a licensure reciprocity agreement with.

If your state does not reciprocate licensure with Colorado, you will need to follow these steps to register to take Colorado's Journeyman Wireman Exam.

Apprentices in Colorado who have attained 288 hours of schooling and 8,000 of On-the-Job Training (OJT) will also follow these steps.

1. Create an account with PSI Exams. This can be done online at <https://candidate.psiexams.com/>. On the righthand side of the homepage, click "Create an Account" under the "New User" banner.
